### Definition & Mode of Baptism

- Definition (baptizo) – “to immerse, submerge; to make whelmed (i.e. fully wet)”
- Mode is a question of authority
- N.T. baptism was by immersion, not sprinkling or pouring

### New Testament Examples of Baptism

- The Jews on Pentecost (Acts 2)
- The Ethiopian Eunuch (Acts 8)
- Saul of Tarsus (Acts 9, 22)

### Purpose of Baptism

- Salvation (Mark 16:16; 1 Peter 3:21)
- Remission of Sins (Acts 2:38)
- Be Born Again (John 3:1-5)
- Wash Away Sins (Acts 22:16)
- Put on Christ (Galatians 3:27)

### False Teaching Regarding Baptism

- Baptism is not necessary to a man’s salvation
- Infant Baptism (As pledge of Parents)
- Improper “modes” of Baptism
- One Baptism of Ephesians 4:5, Not Water Baptism
