Suggestions to Facilitate Study

- Keep all handouts in a 3 ring binder.
- Bring binder to class with you each week.
- Take notes in the box to the right of the outline. If more copious notes are needed, purchase some lined notebook paper.
- Familiarize yourself with the outline, and material to be covered, before coming to class each morning.
- Make it your goal to read through the book of Acts numerous times through the study.
- From time to time, go back through previous outlines and glance over them for review.

Miscellaneous information

- All material covered in the class, including PowerPoint files and audio (mp3 files) of each class period is available online. It is organized well, and you will easily be able to catch up if you missed any class.
- PowerPoint slides will not be printed. However, if you do not have access to the internet, or are technologically challenged, we are more than willing to print up individual slides for you.
